Rules and Regulations

Even though we are out there to have fun, safety is the number one priority for both parade entrants and spectators.

- The parade will take place on Friday, November 23, 2018. Staging will be on Oakland St. next to the tennis courts on the south side of Trumble Park and begin at 5:15 p.m. The parade will step off at precisely 6:00 p.m. and proceed to the Rotary Clock Tower.

- As there is only one Santa, there can only be one Santa in the parade, and he is coming by special invitation of the City of Durand and escorted by the Durand Fire Department. Any other Santas in the parade will be asked to go incognito, or risk disqualification.

- All Entries, including tow vehicles, must be decorated, and well-lit with festive, holiday lighting. Walking entries must display battery powered lights, or a 22 inch glow product, PER PERSON. Other glow products may be substituted as long as the entrant is well-lit. This includes any type of parade entry, wagons, bikes, carriages, animals, etc.

THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS TOO MANY LIGHTS!

The official theme this year is "Silver Bells".

- All entries must incorporate a holiday theme, even if it is not the official theme, into their entry in addition to lighting requirements.
- Holiday music is encouraged at a reasonable volume, however sound systems may not be used for broadcasting messages or agendas.
- Religious expression is permitted, but please be respectful to all faiths.
- There is no limit to the length of an entry, but height cannot exceed 14 ft. (You won't fit under the street lights.) The length of the entry on the application is for staging purposes, please be as accurate as possible. While a Drill Team of 15 might take up 30' while walking, it does not need 30' to stage.
- All materials used must be flame retardant. Portable generators/compressors must be securely mounted. Insurance and liability are the sole responsibility of the entrant.
- Throwing of any items is strictly prohibited. PLEASE DO NOT THROW CANDY. Walking entrants may hand out appropriate holiday items. Distribution of literature or coupons is not allowed.
